Dear Ms Hart,

Thank you for your email and for the opportunity to clarify my decision.

Generally speaking, the OHO is unable to disclose information regarding actions taken in previous matters or what outcome was reached. This is due to our confidentiality requirements for previous notifiers and the practitioner themselves. Regarding the public statements made by Dr Perry in 2021, the OHO is satisfied that the matter has been adequately addressed by both the OHO and by Ahpra, the registering body for medical practitioners. However, the OHO is unable to provide you with the outcome of the decision due to privacy.

In relation to the OHO considering the passage of time which has elapsed since the comments were made, the statements were made four years ago during a specific and time-sensitive public health crisis.

The OHO and Ahpra were made aware of the concerns at the time, and the concerns were addressed accordingly. With the concerns being addressed at the time, in conjunction with the passage of time that has now passed since the statements were made, the risk to public health and safety is considered low and no further action is required.
